



### DWAYNE CARTER PORTFOLIO

Carter has explored narrative figurative art through a variety of mediums including zines, paintings, interactive works, animations, videos and small scale wood and clay relief carvings. Solo exhibitions have included Ball of Confusion at the Kessler Theater in Dallas and Heights Theater in Houston, Week of Kindness at the Ida Greene Gallery in Sherman, Texas, Solo Exhibition at the Theater Gallery, Midway to Madness at the Richland College Brazos Gallery and the Plush Projects space.

Carter's animations have been included in the Aurora New Media Exhibition and his 2011 interactive animated work The Dark Bible was included in the Dallas Video Festival. 


# MADNESS ZINES 2008 2023
